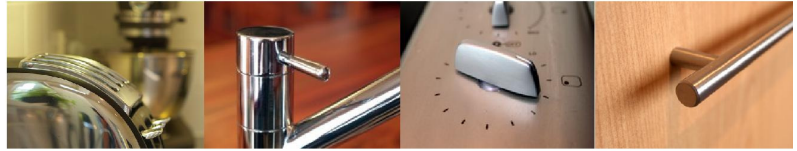

Timber

The importance of using quality timber for joinery is absolutely essential. No splitting, gum pockets, knots or discolouration is imperative to achieve an exceptional finish and to have a lasting quality. It has become much harder to source high grade rimu to the extent that suddenly the availability of good quality rimu has definitely been curtailed. This sad fact was one that we knew would eventually happen but not quite so suddenly. Fortunately there are alternative timbers which we will consider from the Eucalyptus range such as Pilularis, Saligna and the Tasmanian Oak group which are all generally of good colour, straight and sap free.
